

Summer Trip to Minnesota

Dates: August 2-7, 2010

Location: Hudson, WI & the Twin Cities, MN

Plans: Visit the Mall of America, The Minnesota Science Museum (Dead Sea Scrolls), Work at Sharing & Caring Hands (a soup kitchen in Mpls). We may possibly have a Sailboat ride or visit an orphanage. We will take in some popular sights in WI & MN.

Participants: The trip is open to all students 7th grade and up with a LIMIT of 12 available spots.

Transportation: We are planning on taking the Megabus from Ann Arbor to the Twin Cities at the cost of \$60 a person. These tickets will need to be bought right away or the cost will go up. We will have two 7 passenger mini vans available to us for use. We will ask each student to pay \$20 toward gas any remaining funds will be given as a gift to the owners of the vans.

Lodging: We will be staying in a home in Hudson, WI. The home is owned by Rich & Sue's friend, Leslie Helmen. The house has a number of bedrooms and showers. While there we will help out around the house.

Food: Meals on the road, at restaurants or out sight seeing are each person's responsibility. We will pack food when possible and will be able to prepare meals at Leslie's house. We are asking each student to contribute \$30 to the food budget and money that remains will go to Leslie as a gift for opening up her home to us.

Cost: Bus Ticket-\$60 right now they will go up the closer we get to the departure dates, Van Gas-\$20, Prepared Meals-\$30, MN Science Museum+Omnitheater+Dead Sea Scroll-\$34, total = \$144

Other cost will be food while travels and anything you may wish to buy.

What Each Participant will need: *Registration, Medical Release and Permission forms filled out and turned in ASAP with a \$75 deposit to purchase bus tickets. The first 9 individuals who get their forms and money in will be able to go, 3 spots are already taken by Rich, Sue & Ceonni Williams. We will not take any more registrations after June 15 or get 9 individuals, whichever comes first.*
